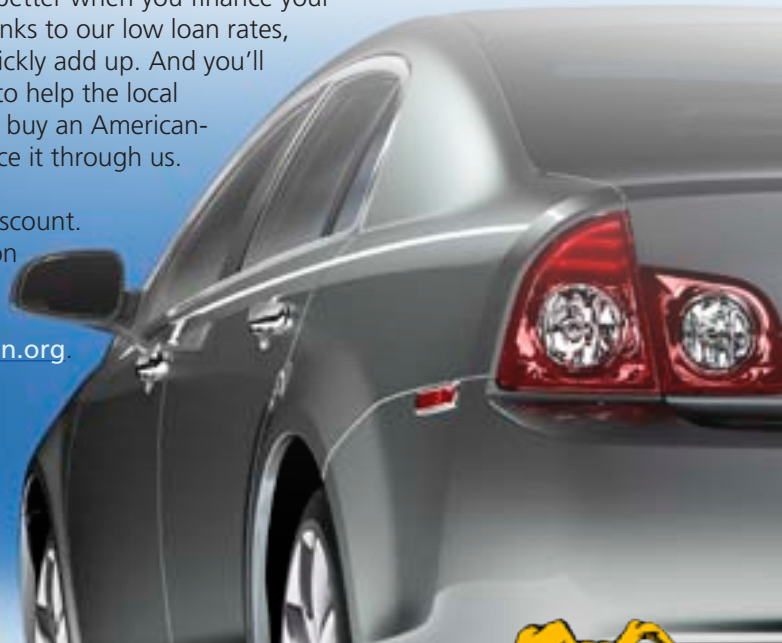

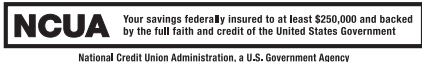

ID Theft Is On The Rise!

When times are tough, scams get more and more common. A recent study showed a 22% increase in identity theft in 2008. Criminals are preying on current concerns, with scams involving debt negotiation, home foreclosure “rescue” schemes, and phony bank merger stories.

Many of these schemes involve direct communications with unsuspecting consumers. Please do NOT respond to phone calls, emails or text messages requesting personal or financial information. Remember, West Michigan Credit Union will never contact you asking for this type of information.
